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**STUDIES REGARDING THE PROBLEMS AND SOLUTIONS IN ANA LUGOJANA FOREST DISTRICT**

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**Abstract:** The forest fund that forms the subject of this management study is administered by the National Forest Administration - Romsilva, through the Ana Lugojana Forestry Department within the Timiș Forest Directorate. Geographically, the territory of the Ana Lugojana Forestry Department is located on the right bank of the Timiș River, in the basin of the Nădrăg Valley.

• **Introduction**

From a phytoclimatic point of view, the forests managed by the Ana Lugojana Forest District are located in the following vegetation levels: Montane - premontane beech forests (FM1+FD4); Hilly beech forests, beech forests and beech forests - beech forests (FD3).

• **Material and method**

The current structure of the forests, the types of forests encountered within the forest district, the current character of the forest type are the direct result of the way forests have been managed over time. The average structure (years) total forest area is 90 years, average production classes Forest Area Ana Lugojana .

• **Results and discussions**

Therefore, the main objective at the level of the Ana Lugojana Forest District is to pursue the objective highlighted in the revenue and expenditure budget of managing state forests under conditions of maximum efficiency and sustainable conservation .
